SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION PROPOSITION TRACK & FIELD

Shall the Board of Education of the Houston R-1 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Dollars (3,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the renovation, construction, equipping, and furnishing of the athletic complex to include a new track and associated event areas; to improve track accessibility; to the extent funds are available, construct, equip, and furnish an outdoor storage facility, install a turf field, prepay principal on existing lease financings and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.8000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
